The work of the Altar & Rosary Society began with the care and maintenance of the altar, but our mission has grown to include a variety of activities and ministries that impact our parish and community. Our organization provides altar bread and wine, devotional and altar candles, and funeral lunches for the families of deceased parishioners. In addition, we support Catholic education through the Bright Futures Fund, The Parkville Women's Clinic, an apartment at Hillcrest Traditional Housing, Catholic Charities, and others. The parish depends on the women of the Society to augment funding and/or serve as ambassadors for specific events. The Parish has always been able to count on the ladies of the Altar & Rosary Society to assist wherever and whenever needed.

We invite all women of the parish to join us, whether as a member in spirit, or as an active participant in one or more of our many ministries—*Our Lady's* Gift Shop, the funeral lunch committee, rosary making, the Purse Project, Mission Sewing, Hillcrest apartment committee, or as a volunteer for parish events. Meetings are held on the second Monday of the month at 6:30 p.m. from September – May in the Wooldridge Center. You are encouraged to attend, although the meetings are not mandatory.

"What matters in life is not great deeds, but great love." These are the words of St. Therese, the patron saint of our parish. During her life, she taught "a spirituality of doing the ordinary, with extraordinary love."
